A NEW DAWN FOR MOTORSPORT IN KENYA

Motorsports Kenya is pleased to announce that on 8th August 2025, the Sports Disputes Tribunal delivered a landmark, precedent-setting judgment directing the Sports Registrar to immediately register Motorsports Kenya as the official National Sports Organization for motorsport in Kenya and to formally notify the FIA of this change.

The Tribunal found that Motorsports Kenya's application met all legal and technical requirements, demonstrated stable and credible leadership, and enjoyed overwhelming stakeholder support from 95% of the motorsport fraternity. The judgment also confirmed that the Kenya Motor Sports Federation Limited (KMSF), having failed to comply with the Sports Act's transition requirements, ceased to be a recognized sports organization and could not claim precedence over compliant applicant.

This ruling is a decisive victory for legality, transparency, and accountability in the governance of Kenyan motorsport. For far too long, the motorsport fraternity has suffered under poor governance, lack of transparency, and exclusionary practices that have caused participation and confidence to dwindle across all disciplines. The Tribunal's decision affirms what stakeholders have long demanded, and fresh start anchored on the rule of law, democratic principles, and inclusivity.

The Tribunal further directed the Sports Registrar to:

- Register Motorsports Kenya within 30 days
- Oversee fresh, democratic elections within 90 days
- Ensure open membership and seamless integration of all legitimate motorsport stakeholders, including those previously under KMSF

Our Commitments:

Motorsports Kenya will immediately:

- Launch an inclusive membership drive open to all clubs, drivers, officials, and fans
- Conduct free, fair, and transparent elections in line with our constitution

- Invest in grassroots driver development programs nationwide
- Stabilize and publish a clear, predictable national events calendar
- Re-engage with international motorsport bodies to secure Kenya's place on the global stage

This judgment is not the end of a contest, as some may view it, it is the start of a united journey. We extend a hand of partnership to the entire motorsport fraternity, including our colleagues from KMSF, to work together in the national interest. Our commitment is clear: the growth of the sport, unity of the fraternity, and Kenya's pride on the international stage will always come first.

We assure every driver, navigator, official, club, fan, and partner that this new era will be marked by openness, fairness, and collaboration. The road ahead is upward, and we are committed to ensuring no one is left behind.

This is a victory not for one faction, but for every Kenyan who believes our beloved sport deserves governance worthy of its talent, history, and potential.

The new chapter begins now and the only way forward is united, transparent, and unstoppable.
